Prominent as both an artist and a writer in the New York art scene since the 1980s, Peter Halley is increasingly recognized as a major inspiration to many of today's emerging artists. Fusing conceptual thinking with sumptuous paint surfaces, Halley's signature abstract, day-glo, geometric works are sought after internationally.
