Polly Apfelbaum has a unique, upbeat approach to her practice, and *Artforum's* Meghan Dailey once observed that her work often seems to "merge into a sea of color." Get inspired by this colorful energy, and take some of the experience with you as Apfelbaum gifts you her new four-hundred-page poster book, which was featured in the May issue of *Artforum* in their "500 Words" series. The artist has shown around the world since her first one-person show in New York in 1986, and she is represented in prestigious collections including those of The Museum of Modern Art and The Whitney Museum of American Art in New York, LACMA, and The Dallas Museum of Art.

The day continues with a private architectural tour with none other than the Dean of the School of Architecture at Princeton University, **Stan Allen**. The acclaimed architect, who works in New York, began his career designing a number of contemporary art spaces in the city, including White Columns. His architectural firm *SAA/Stan Allen Architect* has realized buildings and urban projects in the U.S., South America and Asia. His most recent book is the edited volume *Landform Building: Architecture's New Terrain*, which you will also take home with you.
